Wear tzitzit & kippah and proudly show we are Jewish.



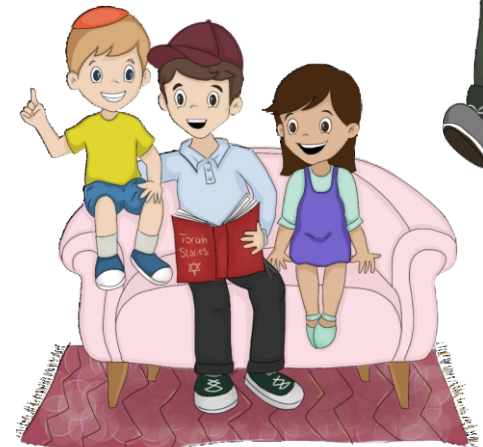
Give tzedakah (charity) and help people in need.
